<b>Educational goals and characteristics</b>	<p>The fellowship will provide extensive post-graduate sub specialty training in the diagnosis and management in foot and ankle surgery with a focus on percutaneous forefoot surgery and total ankle replacement plus complex foot and ankle deformity and reconstruction.</p> <p>Training will be conducted in theatre and clinics. It is expected that the Fellow maintain professional relations and liaise with other members of the multi-disciplinary team (MDT), Orthopaedics Department, intern and registrar and other Hospital staff.</p> <p>Our unit specializes in the latest development in ankle joint replacement using preoperative 3D scanning and the use of patient specific jigs to ensure the most accurate possible insertion of the ankle joint replacement and we believe this will translate into better long-term results and we are conducting ongoing research to demonstrate this.</p>	
<b>Requirements/ criteria</b>	<p>Applicants must have either completed their orthopaedic training (FRACS or equivalent, MS / DNB, American Board or equivalent) or must be in the final year of their training.</p> <p>All candidates must have completed the IELTS Academic English language test (or equivalent) with a minimum score of 7 in every section (<a href="http://www.ielts.org">www.ielts.org</a>). This is a strict criterion for registration with the Medical Board of Australia. Graduates from universities in the USA, Canada, UK, NZ and Australia are exempt.</p>
